During this meeting, the committee discussed the upcoming COQB meeting and expressed a preference for offering an in-person representation moving forward.

The COQB meeting was subsequently held on April 28, 2026, via Webex, without an in-person attendance option. The meeting was virtually attended by Melissa Joyce and Amy Burton.

Key highlights from the April 28th meeting include:

- The contract with PSI Testing has been extended through June 2027, with the final test administration scheduled for April 2027.
- The COQB voted to continue its contract with Question Mark for testing services.
- A motion was introduced to explore moving the “Public Comment” section earlier in the meeting agenda to better accommodate attendees and reduce extended wait times for those wishing to speak.
